PROGRAMS OF STUDY

City Vision College operates on an accelerated semester basis with five 8 week terms each year starting in January, March, June and October. Students may take courses in any of the following ways:

1. ENROLLMENT IN INDIVIDUAL COURSES

All high school graduates may enroll in City Vision College courses. These are upper-level undergraduate courses. Students wishing to pursue a certificate or degree after taking individual courses may apply all credits earned to that program. City Vision College is an Approved Education provider for Certified Fund Raising Executive International and for NAADAC, the association of addiction professionals.

2. DEGREE COMPLETION PROGRAMS

City Vision College offers bachelor's degree completion programs in Missions, Nonprofit Management, and Addiction Studies, as detailed below.

Missions Program: prepares students to lead and to work in Christian social service organizations, primarily those in urban settings. This program provides a Bachelor of Arts in Missions with an urban ministry emphasis.

Nonprofit Management Program: prepares individuals to manage the business affairs of non-profit organizations and ministries. This program provides a Bachelor of Science in Nonprofit Management, and can be used to obtain CFRE (Certified Fund Raising Executive) certification.

Addiction Studies Program: equips Christian workers to work effectively with alcoholics, drug addicts and their family members. This training program provides a Bachelor of Arts in Addiction Studies, and prepares students for certification in a state as an addiction counselor.

All degrees require a total of 120 credit hours and are equivalent to 4-year degrees awarded by accredited residential colleges in the United States. Students may transfer in up to 90 credit hours from outside institutions. At least 30 credit hours - the equivalent of senior year - must be from City Vision College.

3. CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

Certificates in Missions, Nonprofit Management, and Addiction Studies are awarded to students who successfully complete a total of 30 hours of City Vision College course work in an area of specialization. Because each course is worth 3 credits, students must take 10 courses to receive a certificate.

COST

All courses are 8 weeks in length and take about 17 hours of study time per week. The cost per class is \$200/credit hour = \$600. Textbooks must be purchased separately. A 25% discount is available to staff at AGRM member rescue missions.

FINANCIAL AID

Students who qualify for financial aid may use Pell Grants and Federal Student Loans to pay for City Vision College. Some scholarships may be available for specific classes or partner institutions. City Vision College is also approved for educational assistance benefits for qualified veterans and their dependants under programs administered by the US Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). Please call for assistance in applying for financial aid.

TRANSFER CREDIT

City Vision College credits may be transferred to any member of the Higher Education Transfer Alliance, which includes hundreds of colleges and universities as well as most schools that are accredited by the Association for Biblical Higher Education. In addition, City Vision College accepts transfer credits from any institution recognized by the US Department of Education or the International Handbook of Universities. FREE TUITION THROUGH WORK STUDY INTERNSHIPS

City Vision College has a work study internship program to give students on-the-job experience in urban ministry. Internships are available in many major cities in the United States and Canada. Graduates of our programs have had more than a 80% job placement rate.

City Vision interns receive free tuition for a full year of college. In addition, interns who are eligible for Pell grants or other federal financial aid can receive that as a cash payment (up to \$5,645 per year). Interns who serve for 29 hours a week, instead of 20, also are eligible for free housing and meals provided by the hosting ministry (or a living stipend of equal value). Some sites may provide an additional stipend for outstanding applicants.
